Saturday staying in hospital. Insp. Taylor & Supt Cuthbert arrive in Dawson PM from Regina. Supt Cuthbert to take over command from Insp Routhledge acting O.C.

Sunday still in hospital going around outside for exercise

Monday returned to duty from out of hospital but on fatigue hauling wood to town station Const Aikens driving teams

Tuesday was put on the sand team to haul sand of the beach to fill up square, with Const Wallis, Const Graham teamster
