

Donald Cameron was the Director of the Banff School of Fine Arts from 1936-1969 (see note below). David Leighton was appointed by the University of Calgary to succeed him. He had been a professor of marketing at the University of Western Ontario, School of Business Administration. As the Banff School of Fine Arts was at that time under the control of the University of Calgary, the Director reported to the Vice-President (Academic) in the same manner as a dean. There was also an advisory committee of the University Board of Governors that was required to approve new programs or courses, faculty or senior staff appointments, capital expenditures and operating policies.

From their arrival in November 1970, David Leighton and his wife, Peggy, became immersed in all events and aspects of the school, becoming personally acquainted with every staff and faculty member, and many of the participants.

During the course of Leighton's tenure The Banff Centre changed in a number of significant ways. The ties to the University of Calgary were gradually loosened and The Banff Centre for Continuing Education became a fully independent post-secondary institution in 1978. As well, the overall focus of arts programming was shifted towards more advanced artists, and an audition/adjudication process introduced for most programs. Arts programs of several months duration were offered in the winter session, although the summer continued to be the busiest period for short term programs. The Summer Arts Festival was reinvented and intensively marketed through a Canada-wide marketing campaign.

A Cultural Resource Management program was introduced, as well as a short-lived School of the Environment, which offered the first Mountain Film Festival in 1976. The School of Management began to offer more advanced and specialized programs. Leighton was also involved in the establishment of the Banff Television Festival, which was initially affiliated with The Banff Centre.

During Donald Cameron's tenure, the school had been managed by the Director with only administrative assistance from a small core of permanent staff. David Leighton introduced a different management style, hiring more managers, delegating responsibility and establishing committees. He introduced new departments of communications/marketing, fundraising and personnel. The title of the CEO was changed from Director to President, by an amendment to The Banff Centre Act, in February, 1982.

The campus continued the growth that had begun in the 1960's, with the opening of an art studio/gallery building, the recreation centre, a new staff residence, a permanent library and the Max Bell building to serve the needs of management programs and conference groups. The artist colony was also planned and initiated during Leighton's tenure, and was named in his and his wife's honour upon his stepping down in 1982. He was succeeded in the position by Paul Fleck.

Fonds consists of records generated by the overall direction of The Banff Centre, in all of it's aspects. It includes series of files on programs, planning and marketing the Summer Arts Festival, recruitment and liaison with faculty and personnel, liaison with external agencies including the Alberta government, annual budget and financial statements, correspondence relating to the Board of Governors and other governance issues, general planning documents, minutes of committees, files on the organization and general administration of The Banff Centre, and files of general correspondence.

Series consists of files relating to the executive management and marketing of the annual summer arts festival. Student/faculty performances and presentations were an integral part of the summer session since the founding of the school in the 1930's. In 1971 a one-week festival was launched with several major productions and a Canada-wide marketing campaign. The Summer Showcase comprised concert and workshop performances throughout the summer. In 1973 the Festival was expanded to two weeks, and over the decade the format continued to evolve.
